Call for Exhibition Proposals for 2011

Deadline: August 15th, 2010

We invite artists (individuals or groups) to submit proposals for the 2011 Exhibition year.

Your submission **must** include:

- **A proposal including artist statement and project description** (500 words max).
 - **A description of technical requirements for your proposed project** (if applicable).
 - **A Curriculum Vitae** (an artist's resume which features educational, professional and personal facts relevant to your artistic background).
 - **Visual and/or Audio support material for your proposal**
 - **Visual Documentation:** *maximum* fifteen (15) .jpg images clearly titled on DVD or CD. Images are to be no more than 10"/740 ppi on the longest side at 72 ppi.
 - **Video documentation** (if applicable) DVD or CD only (10 minutes max).
 - **Soundtrack** (if applicable)
- Please do not send original artworks. All material must be both PC & Mac OSX compatible.**
- **A list describing all your support material and visual documentation** including titles, media, dimensions of work and year of production. Please specify whether or not they are examples of work or works to be exhibited.
 - **A SASE** (Self Addressed Stamped Envelope) for the return of your support material. All applications without SASEs will be available for pick-up during gallery hours for no longer than 6 months after the Programming Committee's final decision and response.

The Station House Gallery, located in the old P.G.E. train station in Williams Lake, is a public art gallery serving the entire Cariboo-Chilcotin region and is open year round. The gallery offers a minimum of 12 shows per year, at least two of which come from outside Williams Lake.

The Gallery consists of two exhibition areas. The lower (main) gallery measures approximately 70 running feet with an adjoined annex of approximately 23 1/2 feet and meets conservation standards. The upper gallery consists of approximately 46 1/2 running feet. A show may take up one or both gallery spaces.

The Gallery selection committee will choose from among all submissions received to create a diverse and interesting exhibition schedule for 2011. Artists will be notified no later than 60 days after the deadline regarding acceptance.
